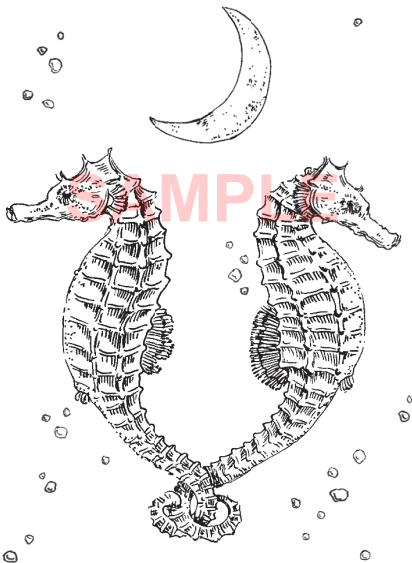

9 OF PENTACLES

Upright: confidence, self-worth, indulgence, abundance, prosperity

Reversed: lack of self-worth, material instability, overspending

Imagery: While the 9 of Pentacles can represent worth and self-worth, this card also signifies indulgence. The card depicts the 9 of Pentacles as a man enjoying the luxurious pleasures of food, doubloons and drink.

10 OF PENTACLES

Upright: "ducks in a row", material stability, financial freedom

Reversed: superficiality, instability, needing financial aid or a plan

Imagery: The 10 of Pentacles generally represents a time when we feel as though

we have everything we could ever want in a material sense—home, money, body, health, etc. This card portrays all these things in ten little boats on the water. Each boat holds a material element. For example, one boat holds a young family. Another boat holds an anchor to represent being on land once again.

PAGE OF PENTACLES

Upright: new project, ambitious, humble, growing finances

Reversed: lacking self-worth, feeling insecure about money, feeling unstable

Imagery: The Page of Pentacles typically suggests a young feminine figure who has big goals and dreams for herself. She can be a little overly serious, but you better believe she always gets to where she wants to go, thanks to her determination. The siren in this card holds two pouches—one in each hand. On the left, she holds her pouch steady. On the right, the pouch is being tossed in the air. This represents

her willingness to invest and utilize her money. She's adaptable and progressive.

KNIGHT OF PENTACLES

Upright: hardworking, slow moving, reserved, thoughtful

Reversed: missing the big picture, focused on insignificant details, perfectionist, needing fun

Imagery: Think of the Knight of Pentacles as that intern who has the tendency to work too hard and miss half the fun of working in an office (socialization!). So, I chose to make the Knight of Pentacles a bit of a bookworm. He is so tied up in his book that he can sometimes forget to be a young person.

QUEEN OF PENTACLES

Upright: beauty, self-worth, abundance, security, sexual power

Reversed: lacking self-worth, misuse of sexual power, greedy, high maintenance

Imagery: The Queen holds a basket full of material goods. She has an overflowing amount of growth and beauty around her. She is the ultimate mother, bringing maternal nature and prosperity with her.

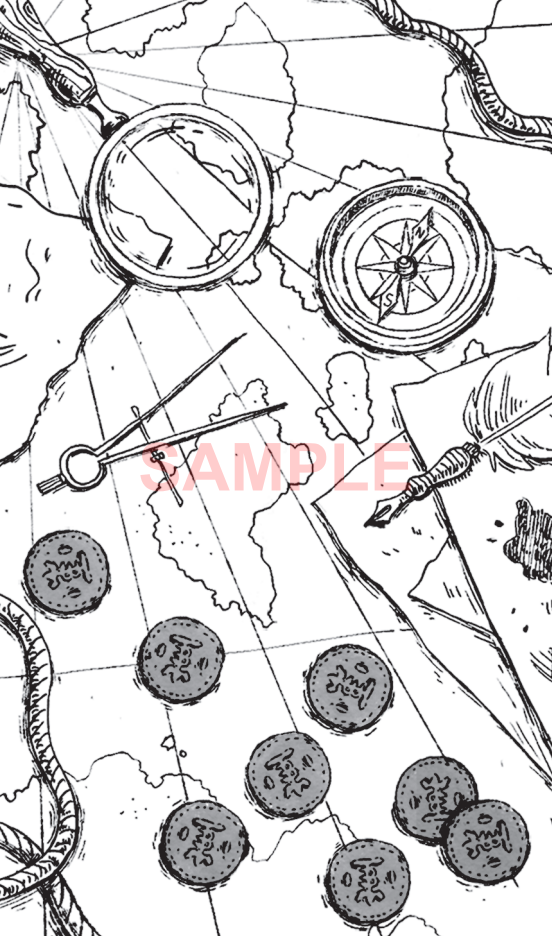
KING OF PENTACLES

Upright: leader, loyalty, successful, steady, trustworthy

Reversed: power hungry, overbearing, controlling, greedy

Imagery: The King of Pentacles shows a man of great stature and status. That's why he holds a treasure chest on his knee—suggestive of prosperity and material prowess. He looks calm, but steady—exactly how the King of Pentacles should be.

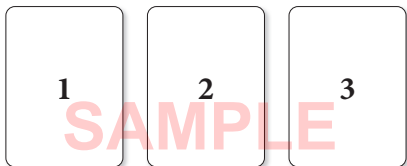




CARD SPREADS

THREE-CARD TAROT SPREAD

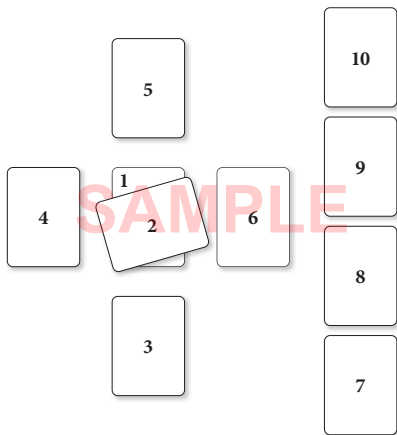
This is one of the most basic spread methods out there. And the best part? There are a number of ways you can use three cards together in a spread. Here are some examples:



- Past / Present / Future
- Me / You / Our relationship
- What I did / What I should have done / What I can learn from this
- The situation / What I know about it / What I don't know about it
- Last year / This year / Next year
- Situation / Obstacle / Solution
- Strengths / Weaknesses / How to progress
- Mind / Body / Soul

CELTIC CROSS TAROT SPREAD

Arguably the most well-known spread out there, I felt that the Celtic Cross spread was important to include. I've modified it from its original version just a touch so that it flows more cohesively.
